Offering high school girls a foundation in the transportation industry and a chance to strengthen their STEM skills.

Students will be introduced to a strong network of women working in transportation in the Portland metropolitan region, helping them to build their leadership skills, strengthen their college applications and envision a possible future for themselves working in transportation. Students are asked to choose a real-world transportation problem to investigate and use the skills they have gained to present a solution at the end of the course.

Half of each day is spent in the classroom hearing from PSU faculty and guest lecturers from ODOT, FHWA, PBOT, TriMet, and more. The other half is spent outside, in field tours of Portland's transportation infrastructure and public spaces.
